





Overview of Japan




- The population of Japan is approximately 125 million. Because of the low Birth Rate, Its population is declining.



Recently, JPY has depreciated sharply against both USD and EUR.






Wood supply / demand in Japan



O After bottoming out in 2009, overall japanese timber supply / demand is on an upward trend. Approximately 80 million m3 in 2020.

■ Changes in wood demand




Wood supply / demand in Japan



O Domestic forest resources have been enriched, and the wood self-sufficiency rate, which used to be less than 20% has risen to over 40%.


Wood supply in Japan



■ European lumber & Laminated wood Import (by country)




Lumber inventories in Japan



Inventories in Tokyo port rose after hitting record low in early 2021, now at all-time high. It is expected to return to normal level in 6 months.


Inventories in Tokyo Lumber Terminal



Housing starts in Japan



- With the declining population, the number of new housing starts is also on the decline.
- Currently, there are about 860,000 housing starts per year, about 58 % of which are made of wood.

Japanese prefers wooden, single unit house



- In recent years, research shows that home buyers have more tendency to choose single unit house.
- O By contrast, preference of new-built condominiums has been gradually declining.



More affordability of single unit house




- Osingle unit price has increased 1.15times in last 10years. (condominium >>1.8times) Osingle unit has advantage for both construction cost and land acquisition.


 Solid demand even if they are far from the station

Ochanges in needs during pandemic also gives good result of single unit house sales. (i.e. remote work)


■ New Single Unit Houses in Stock Tokyo metropolitan area

■ Floor Area of New Construction Starts in 2021



- Revisions of law to expand usage of wood.
- ① Act for Promotion of Use of Wood in Buildings to Contribute to the Realization of a Decarbonized Society (Oct 2021)
- Expanding scope of law from public building to general building.
- 2 Building Standards Law etc. (Jul 2022)
- Rationalizing regulations of fire prevention and structure to promote wood usage.



Summery



- European lumber supply has 9% share in the total Japanese 60Mm3 demand.(except fuel wood/chip).
- Lumber Inventories are now at all-time high and will be normal level in 6 months.
- Overall Japanese housing starts will decline due to aging / depopulation.
- Wooden single unit house demand is stable.
- Revisions of law and easing regulation will enlarge wood utilization for high story buildings and nonresidential buildings.
